

GENERAL RULES FOR NCAHA AWARDS PROGRAM

- NCAHA requires no nomination fee for participation in its yearend awards' program. However, complete information on horse(s), rider(s), handler(s) and owner(s) must be provided. **Point submissions that do not contain complete and accurate information will not be processed. AHA/USEF/USDF print outs will not be processed in lieu of the high point submission forms.**
- Owners(s), riders (s), and handlers (s) must be paid members in good standing at the time the points are earned.
- *******ALL POINTS SUBMISSIONS MUST BE IN WRITING AND POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1, 2011. Please do not send points via certified mail or with signature confirmation.**
- Local (open) shows and Breed (Rated Class A, etc.) show points must be submitted on separate forms.
- Awards for Open and Rated shows will be separated for points tabulation.
- To enable the NCAHA to recognize a greater number of members and horses, class awards will be awarded per horse not horse/rider combination. In addition, multiple awards for individual class divisions for the same horse will be recognized with one award.
- If participation warrants, the following categories of awards are planned. Categories may be expanded, combined, or eliminated at the discretion of the awards committee.

POINTS COMPUTATION

All points will be computed as follows:

REGULAR CLASSES: 1st=5, 2nd=4, 3rd=3, 4th=2, 5th=1.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: 1st=10, 2nd=8, 3rd=6, 4th=4, 5th=2.

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: Champion=12, Reserve Champion=6, Top Five=4.

NATIONAL SHOWS: Champion=30, Reserve Champion=20, Top Ten=10.
